Online registration for SZTE students through MODULO


The first step of the registration process is to fill in, accept the conditions and submit the USZ Library membership declaration in the MODULO system (Submission/Klebelsberg Library/USZ Library membership declaration).

The declaration should only be submitted once, because from the following semester the renewal will be automatic until the end of the university studies.

After the membership declaration is submitted correctly, the last step of the process is a personal data verification at the Loaning section's desk, which can be performed from the first weekday after the online submission during library opening hours.

History of the University Library




- Founded in 1921 when the University of Cluj (Romania) moved to Szeged
- The main building was in Dugonics square + several departmental libraries at different buildings (more than 70)
- 2004: all units moved to this building which is now an integrated library of the University of Szeged




• Floors 1 to 4

- Reading rooms and special collections (more than 400.000 books)
 - Most books are available for borrowing, some are reserved for local use
 - o red label with "stop" sign for local use only
 - red label with a little "moon" icon you can borrow it for the night
 - o ther books: you can borrow them for 4 weeks at the circulation desk (10 books at a time)

Elements of the reading room call numbers:


the first group of characters (numbers, occasionally letters are added, e.g. 02): the **topic of the book**, it gives a general outline of the contents of the book (that is, books with the same notation are side-by-side, therefore users will find books with the **same contents at the same place in all languages**)

the second group of characters (letter+number, e.g. K67): the **place of the book within the topic** (Cutter-number).

The third group of characters on the label is the accessions number, the individual identifier of the copy.

Librarians are available in every reading room to help finding the books and periodicals both in the catalog and on the shelves.

In the reading areas books and journals are marked with **colored labels**. On the 1st floor we use yellow, on the 2nd floor green, on the 3rd floor brown, on the **4th floor blue (sciences) and purple (life sciences) labels**. In the Oriental Collection, the Music Collection we have white, on the journals of 4th floor blue/purple labels.

Online Resources

There are nearly **three times more** online resources (e-books, journals, etc.) than physical stocks.

The reader usually needs the resource, not the database; therefore, every e-document has a record directing you to the **exact title**. The link can be found in the catalog.

Collection of subscribed online journals:

Contents of the databases can **overlap** one another (archive, core or current materials): even the whole journal content can be available in the Library catalog.

Most of the resources are available **without** requiring any **password** but there are password-protected resources, as well.

Save Pages \rightarrow Save Pages to PDF (Page limit: 60 or 100 pages, close the window, search the title again, download 60 or 100 pages more)

E-mail Pages: 60 or 100 pages

Download: it means **borrowing** \rightarrow you have to create an EBSCOhost account (those books which can be used by only one user, cannot be borrowed); the e-book becomes illegible after 30 days

Online resources from home: proxy server

Online resources are available through **academic IP addresses**. With the help of a **proxy server** the online resources of the Klebelsberg Library can be accessed outside the library and the university for students and other registered users of the Library.

Certain settings of the browser should be changed. Please note: after these changes **other public web pages cannot be used** in that browser, only the electronic resources available through the Klebelsberg Library. If you wish to use other sources paralelly, you should open another browser. If you wish to access the public sources in the original browser you have to reset the proxy settings.

For accessing the service you need a **user name** (the number on your student's or reader's card) and **password**, which is derived from your birth date.

We **refresh** our database of registered users in **every 24 hours**, therefore this service will not immediately be available for you after your registration or change of your card.

Please note that the trials are not available from home, neither with the help of the proxy server.



EdulD is the user authentication and authorization federation of the Hungarian educational and research institutions. The aim of edulD is to allow the use of services of its members and partners in a mutually agreed, trusted way.

When a user attempts to access such a service, it is their **home institution** that authenticates them to do and authorization is based on the user information originating from their home institution.
