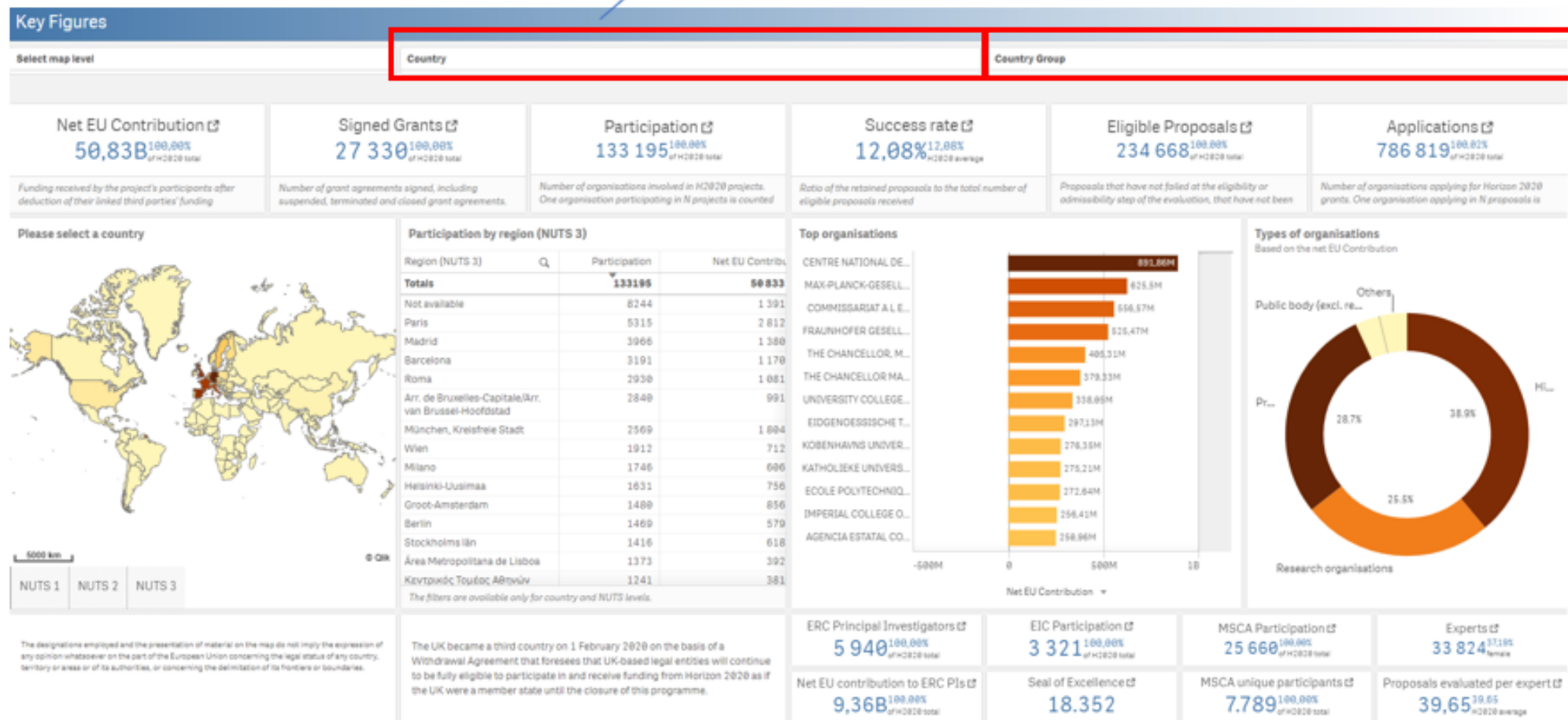

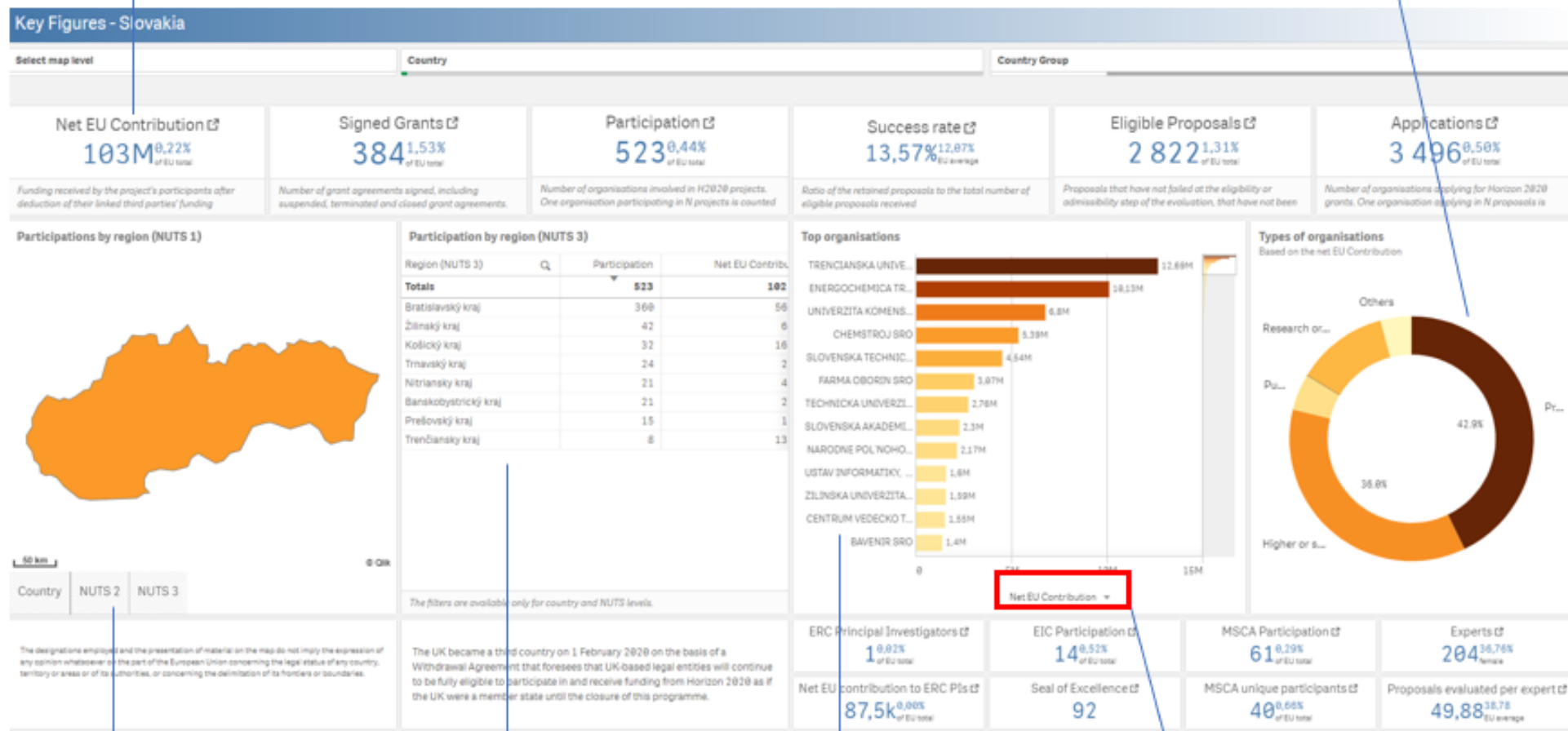
Horizon Dashboard

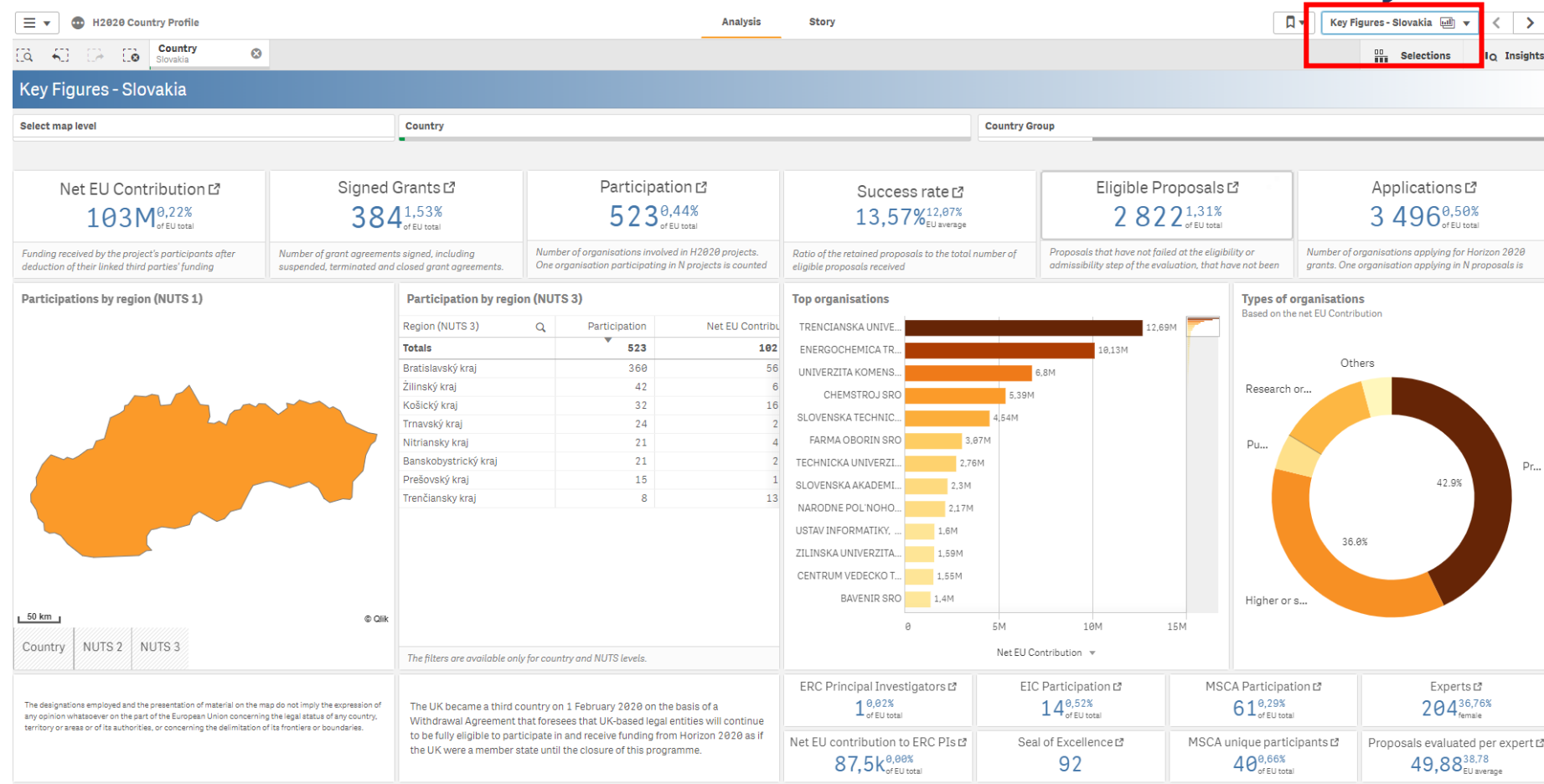

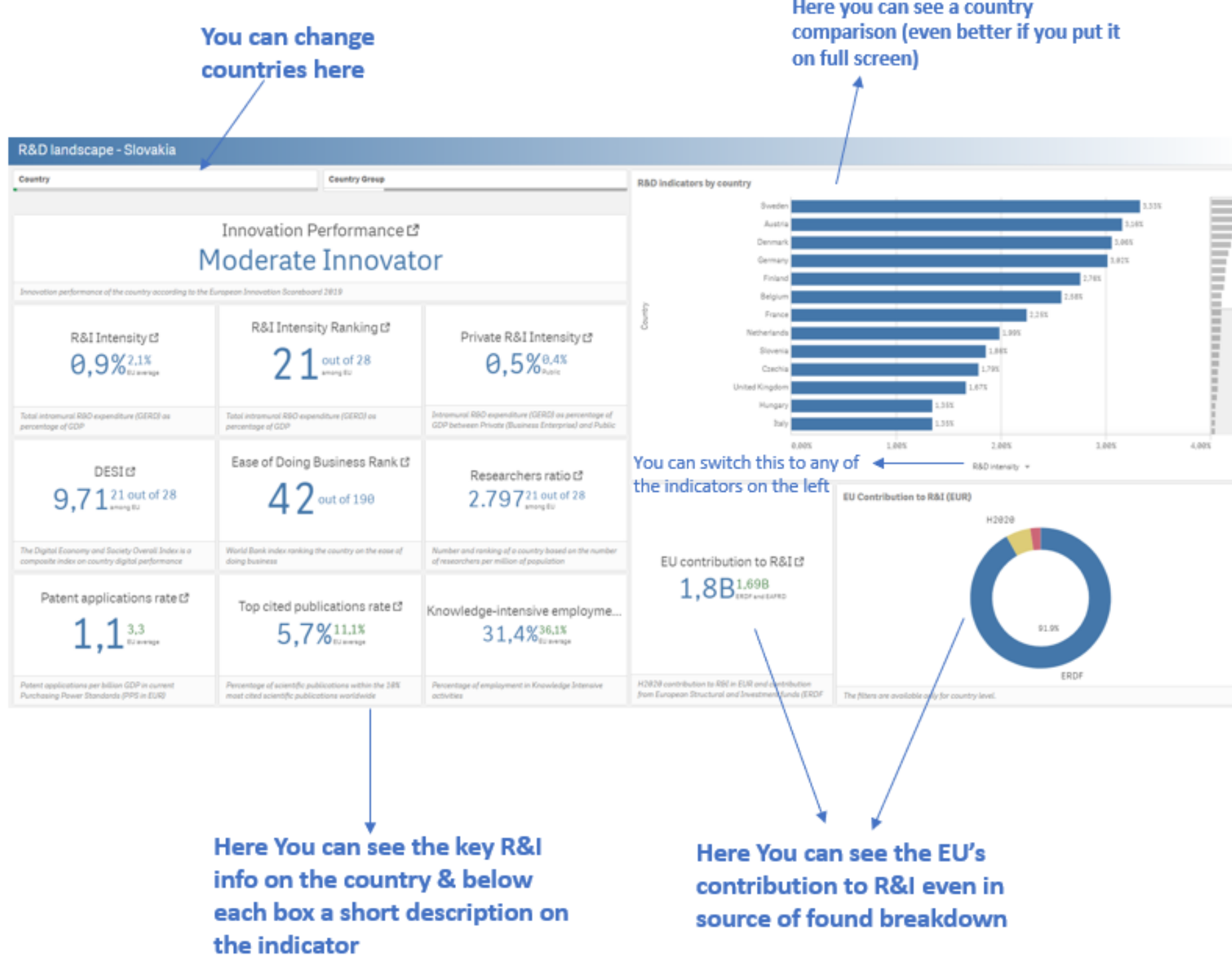
