- Choose a country group that you wish to analyse:
 - o Northern Europe Sweden, Finland, Denmark
 - o Baltics Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania
 - o Central Europe Hungary, Poland, Czech Republic
 - EU big economies Germany, France, Austria
 - Mediterranean countries Spain, Italy, Portugal
 - o Benelux countries Belgium, Netherlands, Luxembourg
