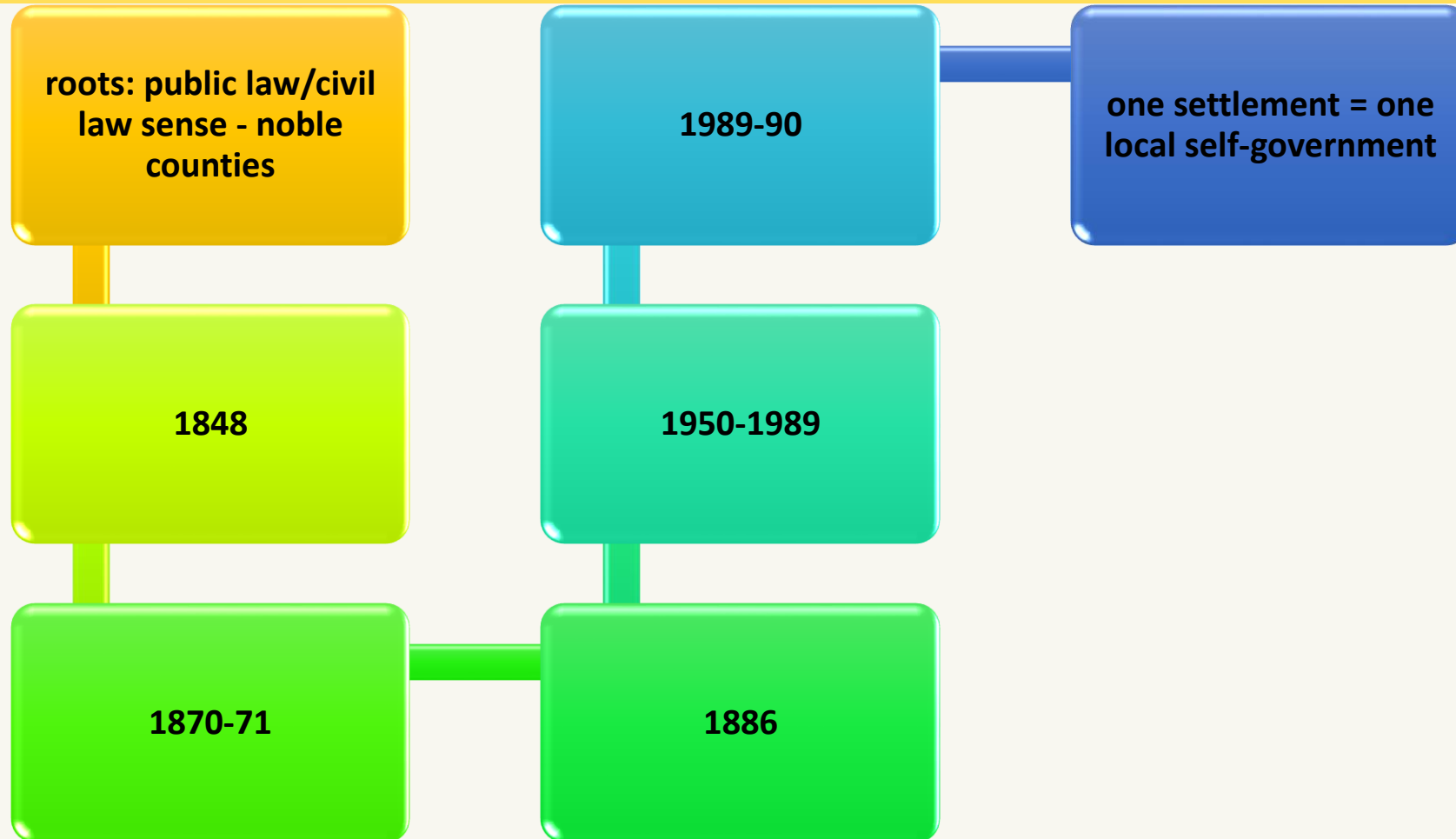

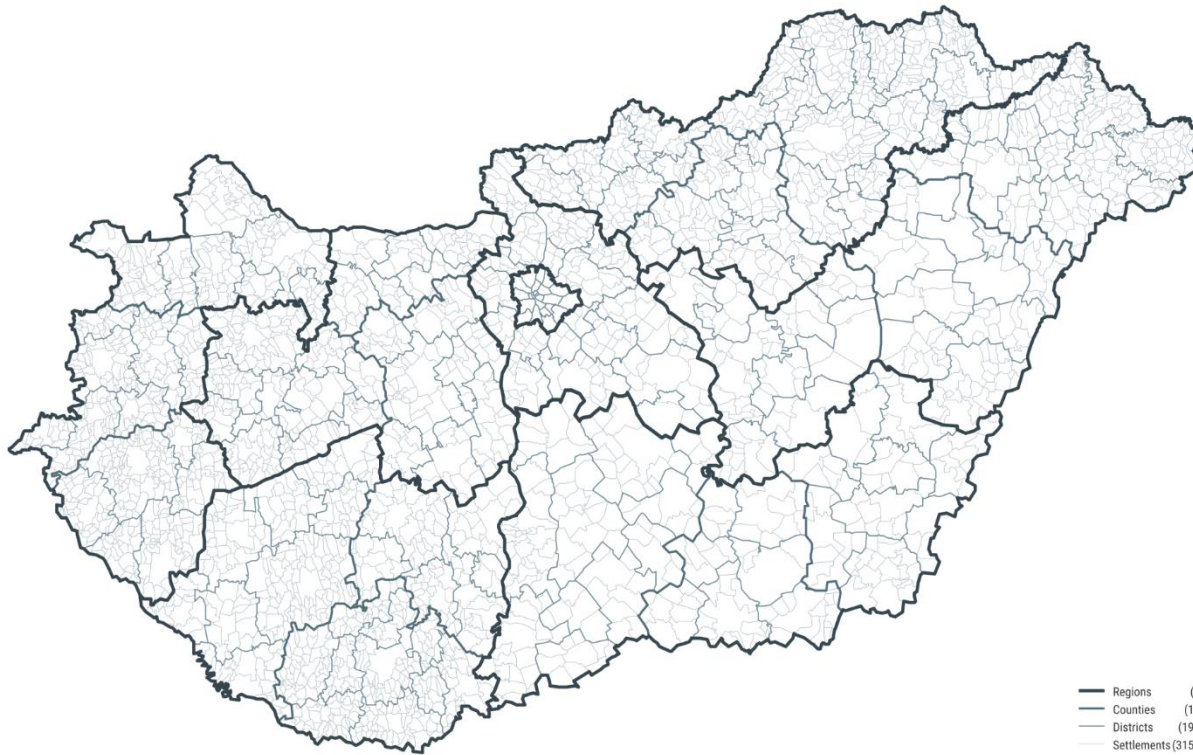

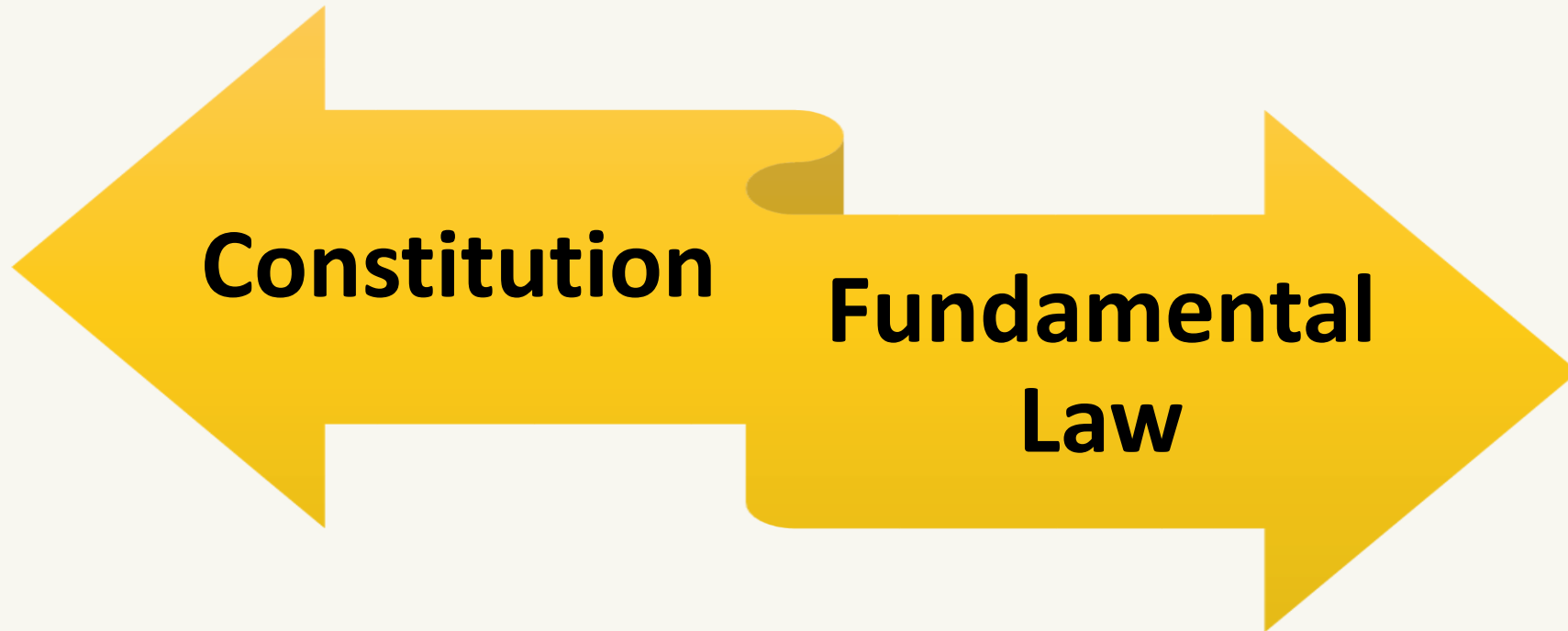


THE PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION STRUCTURE OF HUNGARY, 1 JANUARY 2019
