scope of own and delegated competences	• reverse centralization trend
full and exclusive powers	• limit the interferences of the State
counties have almost no significant competences	• strenghten the position of counties
consultation mechanism	• fair and effective
organisational autonomy	• high quality staff, increase organisational autonomy
supervision not proportional	• importance of the interests
financial resources remain insufficient ("solidarity contribution")	• sufficient financial resources
lack sufficient financial resources from local taxes and charges	• strenghten fiscal capacity
equalisation mechanism	• revise its fairness and transparency
grants mostly earmarked	• fair and transparent allocating mechanism
legal protection	• to guarantee
